

ADMISIONS'S PROCEDURE

We ask parents to register their child for a nursery place as soon as the child is two years old. Please come along to the school office in the main building. We ask parents to indicate a preference for a morning or afternoon place and we do our best to allocate the place asked for. This is not always possible and the alternative may be offered. Both sessions are of equal length and value! Nursery places are offered according to age, the length of time on our lists does not make any difference. If there are special circumstances that a parent feels make it important for their child to be offered a place as a matter of urgency please call and see the Headteacher.

In the year prior to the time of entry to reception a detailed, local authority application form has to be completed. Where the child is in our nursery, we will remind parents to do this. There are also notices in the local newspapers and posters in local shops and health centres. Again, please come to the school office. Please note that having a place in Nursery does not guarantee a place in the main school. We follow the Local Authority guidelines for admitting children to our school.
