

Drama workshops...

Last year KS2 had the privilege of working each week with a drama specialist from a company called Artis. She worked with the children to link their topic themes with writing and language through drama.

This week she returned to continue her work, spending an afternoon with each class to support their current topics through drama.



Years 3 and 4, whose topic is **Ancient Egypt**, took on the role of Egyptian gods. They had to decide on a special quality/talent their god would have and use this to present a scenario to the rest of the class, through drama working in a small group.



Years 5 and 6, whose topic is **Vicious Vikings**, had to research a Viking god of their choice and practice characteristics of these gods. They then had to tell the story through drama, again working in small groups, performing to the rest of the class.



The children and staff had a great time, developing language and a fuller understanding of their topic, through the medium of drama.
